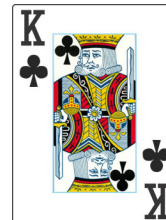

Marco Meals of Hope is a joint effort of Kiwanis, Noontime Rotary and Sunrise Rotary Clubs. It is a hands-on approach to combating hunger in our community. Volunteers work year-round raising funds for its packaging event at Marco Island Charter Middle School. This year's packaging event is scheduled for November 16, 2019. Last year, volunteers packed over 250,000 meals, all of which will be distributed in the Collier County needy families and many on Marco Island itself.

According to Morris, “Our restaurant supporters and the Marco Island Historical Society make our packaging event a success. When we gather at the Marco Island Charter Middle School to package meals, we have already raised the money needed to buy the raw materials. Without the happy hours and financial donations, all the volunteers in the packaging event would be useless.”
